## VOLUNTEER OPPORTUNITIES CRPD

**COMMUNITY CENTERS** are always looking for a variety of volunteers to assist us in a variety of programs and functions at the centers and throughout the city. If you are interested please contact any of the community centers listed at the bottom for more details.

- **CLASS/PRE-SCHOOL VOLUNTEER** – The community centers run many classes from parent/child, sports, arts and crafts, gymnastics, dance, specialty classes, as well as preschool and pre-k programs for 3 to 5 year olds that the instructors could use assistance with. The majority of the programs are for 3 to 12 year olds and meet at a variety of times throughout the week.
- **HOMEWORK CLUB** – Some of the centers offer homework clubs at elementary schools and are in need of volunteer tutors to assist the children after school with their homework.
- **SPECIAL EVENTS** – The centers offer one time special events at each of their centers throughout the year along with our community wide special events that bring the whole community together at a specific park in the city. This is a great way to help out on one day.
- **OFFICE ASSISTANCE** – The centers are occasionally in need of office assistance at certain times of the day, evenings or weekends to assist the staff with a variety of duties from answering phones, filing, assisting customers and many other things.
