Do you need help with Medicare's Annual Enrollment Period? Certified HICAP counselors will be available (by appointment only) to guide you through the process and answer your questions. Explore new coverage options; compare plans to find the best fit for your needs; make sure your current prescriptions are covered; ensure you're getting the best value for your healthcare. The Ventura County Area Agency on Aging's (VCAAA) Health Insurance

Counseling and Advocacy Program (HICAP) will be hosting One-Stops (in-person appointments) to assist local residents with navigating 2025 Medicare Open Enrollment. An appointment is required to meet with a counselor. To schedule an appointment, you must first complete the HICAP Comparison-Appointment Request Form.

A **VCAAA** representative will contact you to schedule an appointment once the form is received.




