

The Conejo Community Center was built in 1965. Much like your home, as it ages, additional maintenance costs are incurred due to deterioration and inefficiencies. An assessment of the facility, with comprehensive input from the public, will allow CRPD to address infrastructure and repair issues, evaluate the needs of the community, and determine if a new, or renovated, facility is required to meet these needs.
